

Junior Leaders 4-H Club

By-Laws 2010

Article I. The officers shall be elected every January. To be eligible for an officer you must be a member for one year.

Article II. An audit of the Treasury shall be made each year by the Treasurer of the Saddle Horse Association after the fair, but before the September meeting.

Article III. The office of any club officer who obtains two unexcused absences shall be declared vacant and will be replaced.

Article IV. Should the club members vote to disband any monies the club has will be turned over to the Summit County 4-H Saddle Horse Association to be used for County 4-H Saddle Horse Events.

Article V. Any member acting as a counselor for Junior Leader 4-H Horse Day Camp will only be expected to pay half of the enrollment fee to attend horse camp.

Article VI. Any member of this club found smoking, drinking, using foul language or any other unbecoming act at the Summit County Fairgrounds function, club meeting or any other organized 4-H or horse event will be warned once and then be removed from the club.

Article VII. The purpose of this club is to be good influences on all of the younger kids and to portray good leadership and helpfulness to all in need. You must remain on your best behavior and prove to be a good Junior Leader for yourself, your club, your community, your country and your world.

Junior Leaders 4-H Club Constitution 2010

- Article I.** This club will be called Junior Leaders.
- Article II.** Club colors will be black and purple.
- Article III.** You must be 14 years of age as of January 1st of this year to be eligible.
- Article IV.** You must be an active member of an existing Summit County 4-H Group to be eligible.
- Article V.** The purpose of this club is to train Teens in leadership and teaching skills by being a counselor at Junior Leader 4-H Horse Day Camp and possibly running their own open Horse Shows or other Fund Raisers.
- Article VI.** You must Attend 20 hours training and pass interview to be a new counselor. Safety Training, workdays and shopping day is mandatory for all counselors.
- Article VII.** Counselors cannot have more than 2 unexcused absences from meetings from January through June of a given year. Missing more makes you ineligible to be a Camp Counselor for given year.
- Article VIII.** Advisors in Training (AIT) are college age or have graduated the 4-H Horse program and/or are of 19 years of age.
